

Dog Park Meeting Minutes
April 12, 2017

1. Update on becoming a members only park
 - Our goal is to become members only by the end of 2017
 - Yearly Cost is still to be determined

2. Lance Silver from Mitchell Commons made a presentation about beautifying the dog park
 - they would add landscaping to make the park more appealing
 - new fence and nice looking entrance from the street
 - they would add 20 or 30 parking spaces
 - It would benefit the city because they wouldn't have to maintain it (the city does not maintain this park)
 - Mitchell commons would purchase the land and give the dog park a free long-term lease
 - Parking would directly benefit the apartment complex, but would relieve pressure to those who live in the neighborhood
 - Mitchell commons may or may not be allowed to have dogs in the apartments

3. Open Discussion after Lance's Presentation
 - The members present at the meeting want to see a formal presentation from the Mitchell Commons Developer

4. We are working on a grant with the city
5. We are looking for an attorney to review our bylaws before we become members only
6. We are updating our bylaws
7. An idea was presented to have different levels of membership - voting and non-voting - board will discuss these ideas as we re-write our bylaws.
